

OUTCOMES OF COURT APPEARANCE

- Concluded with final order | A final order was issued resolving all issues in the petition.
- **Final order modified** | A final order was issued modifying a prior order.
- **Order terminated** | An order of child support was terminated by the court because the subject child reached the age of 21 years or was emancipated as defined under the law.
- **Case settled** | The parties reached a settlement agreement resolving all issues in the case and the court entered an order reflecting that agreement or the parties signed an agreement that was signed by the Judge and entered as an order by the court.
- **Temporary order entered** | The court issued a temporary order (e.g., a temporary order of child support or a temporary custody/visitation order or a temporary order of protection) for the first time.
- **Temporary order continued** | A temporary order in the case continued. (Note: for each sequential court appearance where a temporary order is continued, it is typical the court would issue a new temporary order with the date of the court appearance on which the order was continued.)
- **Temporary order modified/terminated** | A temporary order was changed or terminated.
- **Adjourned** | The court scheduled a follow-up appearance.
- Dismissed by court ruling | The case is over.
- Petition withdrawn | One party withdrew the original petition they filed.
